Donna Van Shura, Judy Surak, Michelle Balega and John Leshock all addressed City Council at length regarding the permitting of vehicles used by Snyder Trucking to use South Shamokin Street for hauling material to Black Diamond Mining Inc. of Atlas PA. A petition containing approximately 125 names of residents of South Shamokin Street in opposition to the permitting was presented to City Council. Council was presented with complaints concerning dirt, noise speed and weight of the trucks. Drivers were allegedly using cell phones while driving. Complaints were made about the blue and black smoke coming from the exhaust of the truck vehicles.

Pamela Grow of South Shamokin Street retired director of nursing had concerns with the health issues created by the dust that the trucks produce while using Shamokin Street.

Mary and Sidney Tharp addressed Council with the same concerns regarding truck traffic on Sunbury Street (Rt61) in Shamokin.

Mr. Jerry Splane of Sunbury Street in Shamokin addressed Council about the dirt trucks were causing for his property. He also requested that Council should provide for safe crosswalks for the children and pedestrians on Sunbury Street, especially around the intersection at Ninth Street. He also commented that cars were not being ticketed for cross parking in the city.

Diane Scheleg of 551 S Seventh Street in Shamokin spoke to council with a complaint that her neighbor has two driveways in front of his property. She claims that the man does not live in one of the homes but is just doing periodic renovations. She had questions about brick work for code officer Barry Stoud. The mayor directed Public Safety Director Milbrand to look into the properties at 547 and 549 S Seventh Street.
